Statistics tell us that about 1 in 3 women will experience domestic abuse at some point in her lifetime, and more than 40% of Black women experience domestic abuse, significantly higher than other women.*

The rate of abuse in our Christian families is similar to families outside of the Christian faith.**

Our approach to healing:

- Point women to God, not saying if they should stay or leave
- Use Biblical principles as guidance, not preaching
- Empower women to make choices, not give advice
- Offer support and encouragement, not judging
- Prayer is available, but not required.
